

Crisis mental health services, including 24-hour mobile crisis teams, emergency crisis intervention services, and crisis stabilization.

Patient-centered treatment planning or similar processes, including risk assessment and crisis planning.

Screening, assessment, and diagnosis, including risk assessment.

Peer support, counselor services, and family supports.

Outpatient mental health and substance use services.

Psychiatric rehabilitation services.

Intensive, community-based mental health for members of the armed forces and veterans

Outpatient clinic primary care screening and monitoring of key health indicators and health risks (e.g., BMI, blood pressure, tobacco use, HIV/Viral Hepatitis).

Targeted case management.

START CCBHC

(CERTIFIED COMMUNITY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CLINIC)

A Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic model is designed to ensure access to coordinated comprehensive behavioral health care. CCBHCs are required to serve anyone who requests care for mental health or substance use, regardless of their ability to pay, place of residence, or age - including developmentally appropriate care for children and youth.
