Coordinated Entry & Street Outreach

We seek to provide people experiencing homelessness with the fastest possible access to housing, prioritizing the limited resources to those people with the greatest need. Services are provided both at the One Stop and through daily street outreach efforts throughout the community.

Assertive Community Treatment (ACT):

Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) serves people who have a severe and persistent mental illness that seriously impairs their functioning in the community. The individual must have one of the following diagnosis: Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective Disorder, Other Psychotic Disorder, Bipolar Disorder, or Major Depressive Disorder. Participants must have Medicaid.

Start Community Health Center

Our Community Health Centers offer both Primary Care and Behavioral Health services. Medicaid, Medicare, Private Insurance and Uninsured accepted. Now accepting new patients.

Housing Programs

Start coordinates several housing programs which include both HUD housing and Permanent Supportive Housing. Start provides subsidy administration and supportive services to people experiencing homelessness through our various permanent housing programs.

Veteran Services

Services are available for Veterans and their families. These include individual case management, peer support, housing resources, connection to community resources, mental health screenings, suicide prevention and referrals to other services needed to maintain permanent housing.

The One Stop Homeless Services Center

Start provides a wide variety of services for people at-risk of or experiencing homelessness. At the One Stop, our services include showers, laundry, housing navigation, homeless hospitality, primary and behavioral healthcare, computer lab, and mail distribution. Other services provided are free legal aid, PATH, and more. The goal of the PATH Program is to reduce or eliminate homelessness for individuals with a serious mental illness or co-occurring serious mental illness and substance use disorders, who are experiencing homelessness or are at imminent risk of homelessness. Services include outreach, case management, and access to a SOAR benefits specialist.
