

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES (SSVF)

At Start Corporation you can find a skilled, experienced Community Support Specialist (CSS) who has helped Veterans just like you in finding and obtaining Permanent Housing. Using Housing First and Rapid Rehousing program components, your CSS will help you identify and connect to supports needed to maintain permanent housing.

Referrals to other Veteran and community services can be made to help overcome housing barriers. Many clients report rapid progress due to the effective approaches we employ. All communications with your CSS are kept strictly confidential.

GRANT PER DIEM (GPD)

Grant Per Diem (GPD) provides transitional housing and support services to single homeless Veterans. Currently there are 21 units designed to stabilize housing while exploring permanent housing options.

- Veterans are provided intensive case management services
- Assistance with transportation
- Provides support with public resources and benefits
- 12 single occupancy units that are service intensive
- 9 single occupancy units that are low demand beds

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STAFF SERGEANT PARKER GORDON FOX SUICIDE PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM

The Staff Sergeant Parker Gordon Fox Suicide Prevention Grant Program (SSG Fox SPGP) enables VA to provide resources toward community-based suicide prevention efforts to meet the needs of Veterans and their families through outreach, suicide prevention services, and connection to VA and community resources.

Eligible individuals:

- Individual that is determined to be at risk of suicide
- Veteran: defined as a person who served in the active military, naval, air, or space service, and who was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable.

SSG Fox SPGP honors Veteran Parker Gordon Fox, who joined the Army in 2014 and was a sniper instructor at the U.S. Army Infantry School at Fort Benning, Georgia. Known for a life of generosity and kindness to others in need, Fox died by suicide on July 21, 2020, at the age of 25. To learn more about Start Corporation, visit www.startcorp.org.
