GRANT PER DIEM (GPD)

The Grant and Per Diem (GPD) program provides transitional housing and support for single homeless Veterans as they work toward permanent housing.

We offer 21 single-occupancy units:

- 12 service-intensive units
- 9 low-demand beds

Veterans receive case management, transportation support, and help accessing public resources and benefits all in a safe, stable environment that promotes recovery and independence.

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STAFF SERGEANT PARKER GORDON FOX SUICIDE PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM

The Staff Sergeant Parker Gordon Fox Suicide Prevention Grant Program (SSG Fox SPGP) enables VA to provide resources toward community-based suicide prevention efforts to meet the needs of Veterans and their families through outreach, suicide prevention services, and connection to VA and community resources.

ELIGIBILITY:

- At-Risk Individuals: Persons identified as being at risk for suicide.
- Veterans: Individuals who have served in the active military, naval, air, or space service, and were discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable.

SSG Fox SPGP honors Veteran Parker Gordon Fox, who joined the Army in 2014 and was a sniper instructor at the U.S. Army Infantry School at Fort Benning, Georgia.
